A man named Clymer H. Freas was the editor of a small paper in Pennsylvania. He callied the town's groundhog the "Official Groundhog Day meteorologist." Groundhog Day was born!

According to the legend, if it is cloudy and the groundhog does not see his shadow, spring will come early! If the groundhog sees his shadow, then winter will continue for six more weeks!

Over the past 29 years, the groundhog has been right 14 times and wrong 15 times! Still, it is a fun tradition!
