As soon as the gingerbread man was out of the oven he jumped down and ran away shouting: "Run as fast as you can. You can't catch me I'm the gingerbread man!"




He ran so fast nobody could catch him. Even the cow and pig could not catch him.




When he came to a river he could not cross, a sneaky fox talked him into getting on his tail. When he got wet he kept moving forward. Until the fox finally ate him up!









The second pig built a house of sticks. It was not strong either. The big bad wolf came along. He huffed and puffed and blew it down.





The third pig worked hard and built a strong house of brick. The wolf could not blow it down. The other pigs ran to his house.

The medium sized goat went next. When the troll stopped him, he, too said to wait for a bigger goat was coming. Again the greedy troll let him pass.



