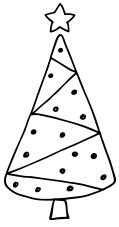

These are great for a gift party, such as a white elephant gift. Each player holds a gift. The host reads the story aloud. As the words left or right are said the players pass the gift in that direction. They receive the gift they are holding when the story ends.
