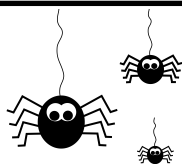

next part of this tale.

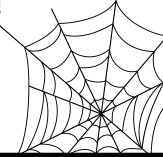


If you want to play with toys

be the very best.

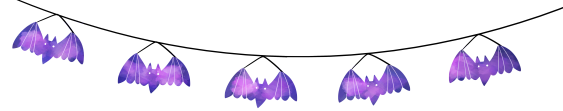
When you need to put on

When you want to zoom so fast, you'll pedal me with your feet. Come and find me and you'll see the next clue to find your treat!



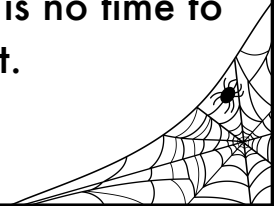
If someone comes to visit, stop and knock on me they'll do. Look near me to see if there is something there for you.
