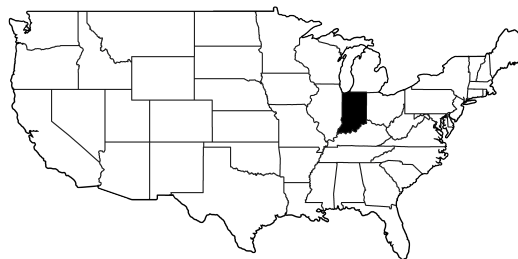

Tulip Poplar



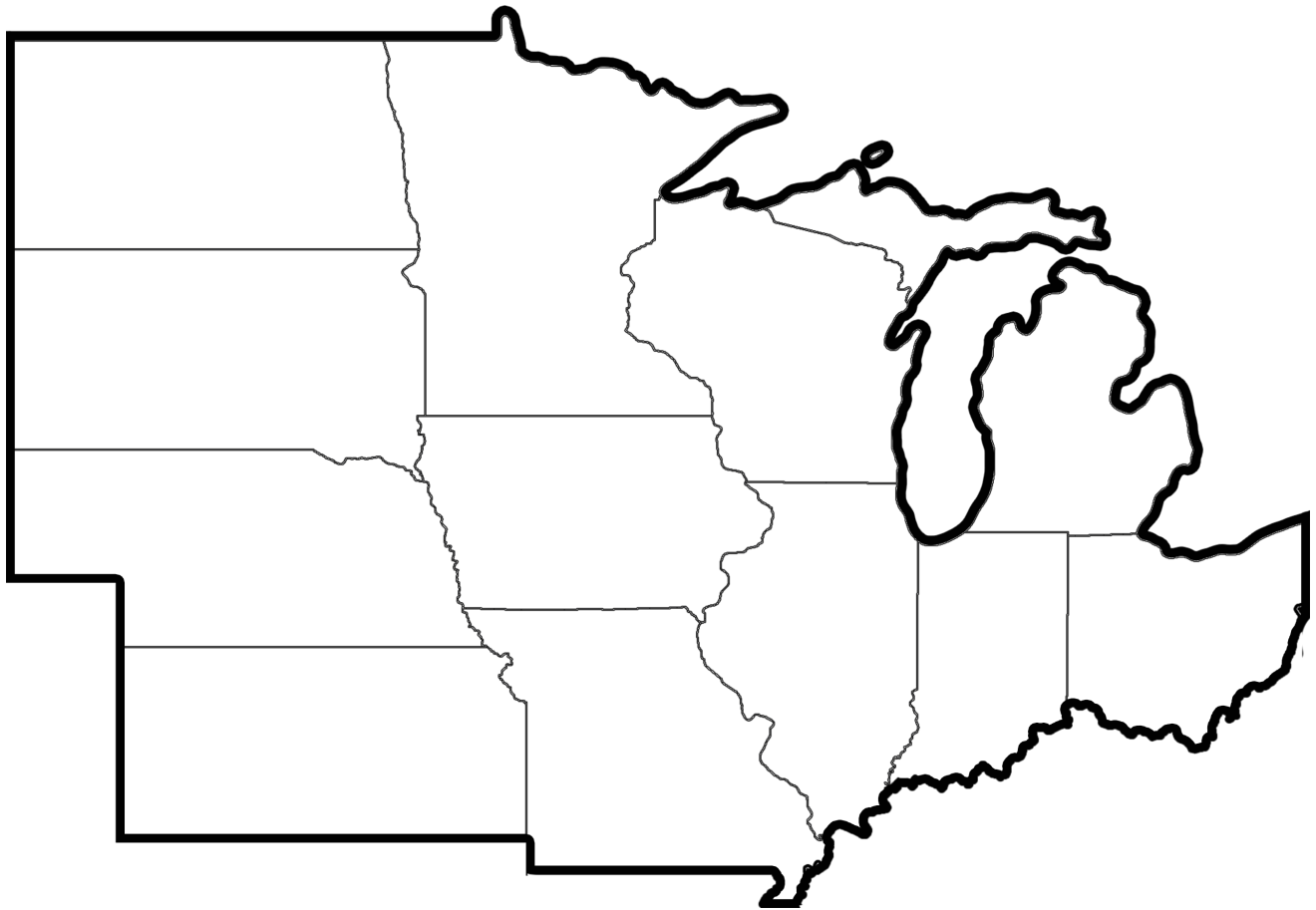

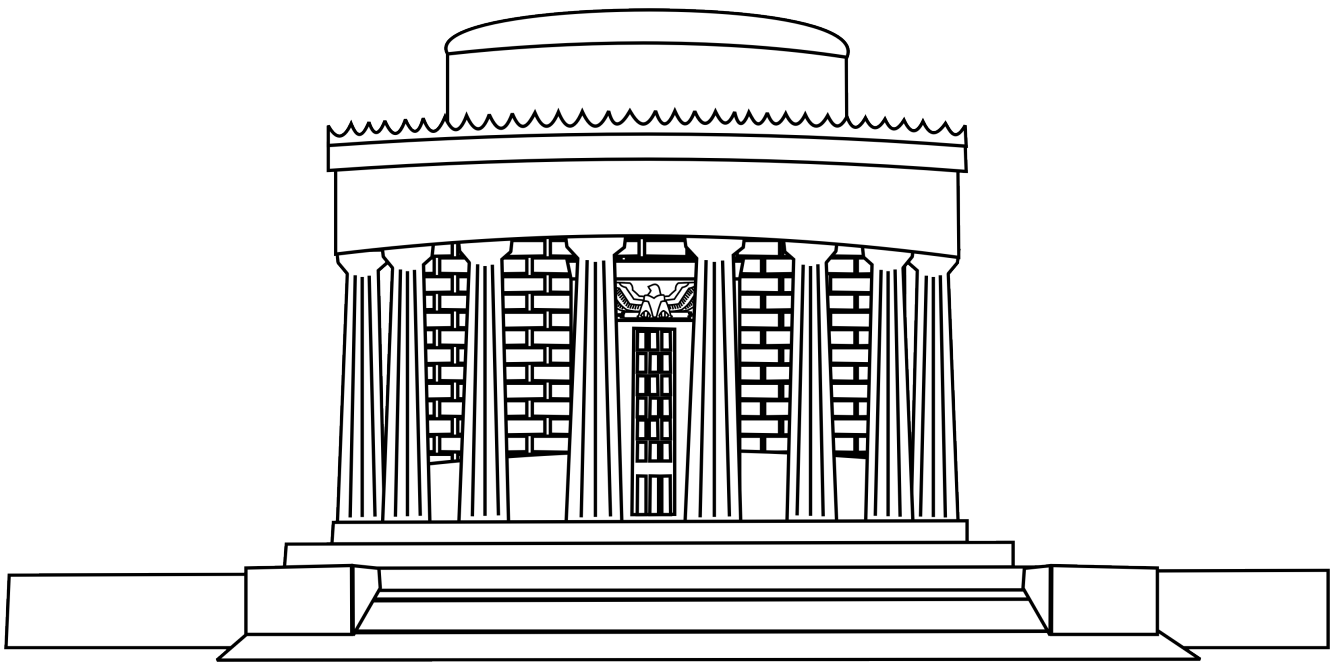

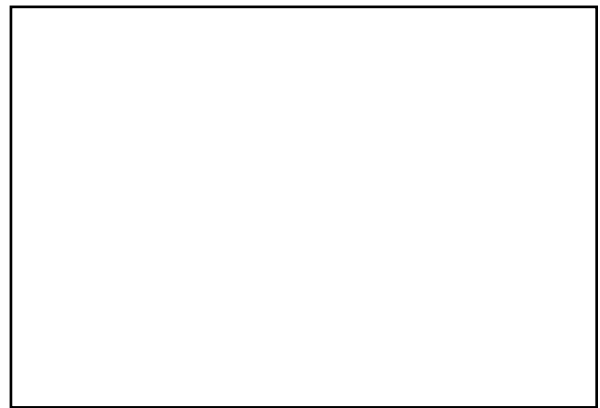

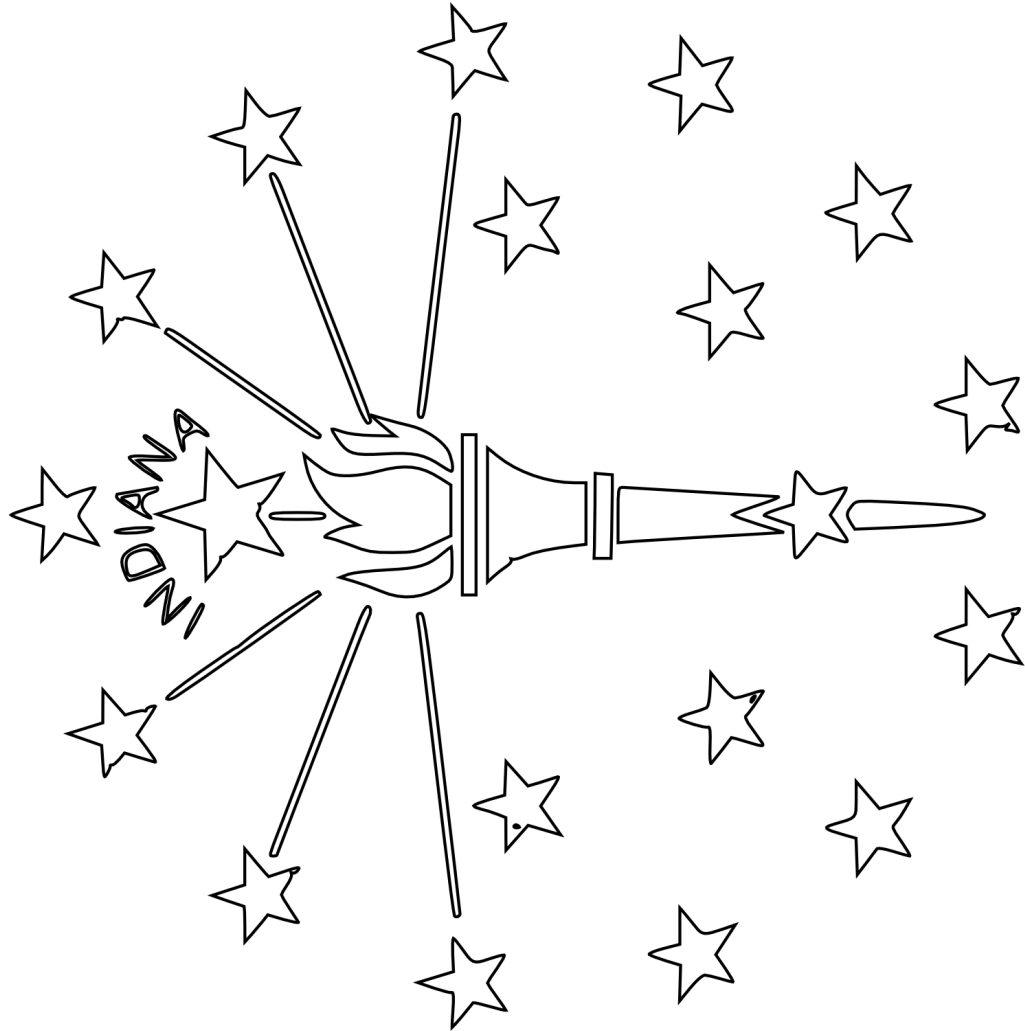
