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HOW TO PLAY PATRIOTIC SCATTERGORIES

Scattergories is a fun, fast-paced thinking game. Use the spinner wheel to pick a letter, then fill in each category with a word that begins with that letter—before the timer runs out!

What You Need

- Spinner wheel (included in this pack)
- One arrow pointer + brad fastener
- Category page
- Answer sheet
- Timer
- Pencils

How to Play

1. Place the spinner wheel in the center and spin to choose the round's letter.
2. Set a timer for 2–3 minutes.
3. Write one answer for each category that begins with the chosen letter.
4. When time is up, read answers aloud and score the round.

Scoring

- Unique answer = 1 point
- Duplicate answer = 0 points
- Blank = 0 points

Optional: Double points if both words start with the chosen letter.

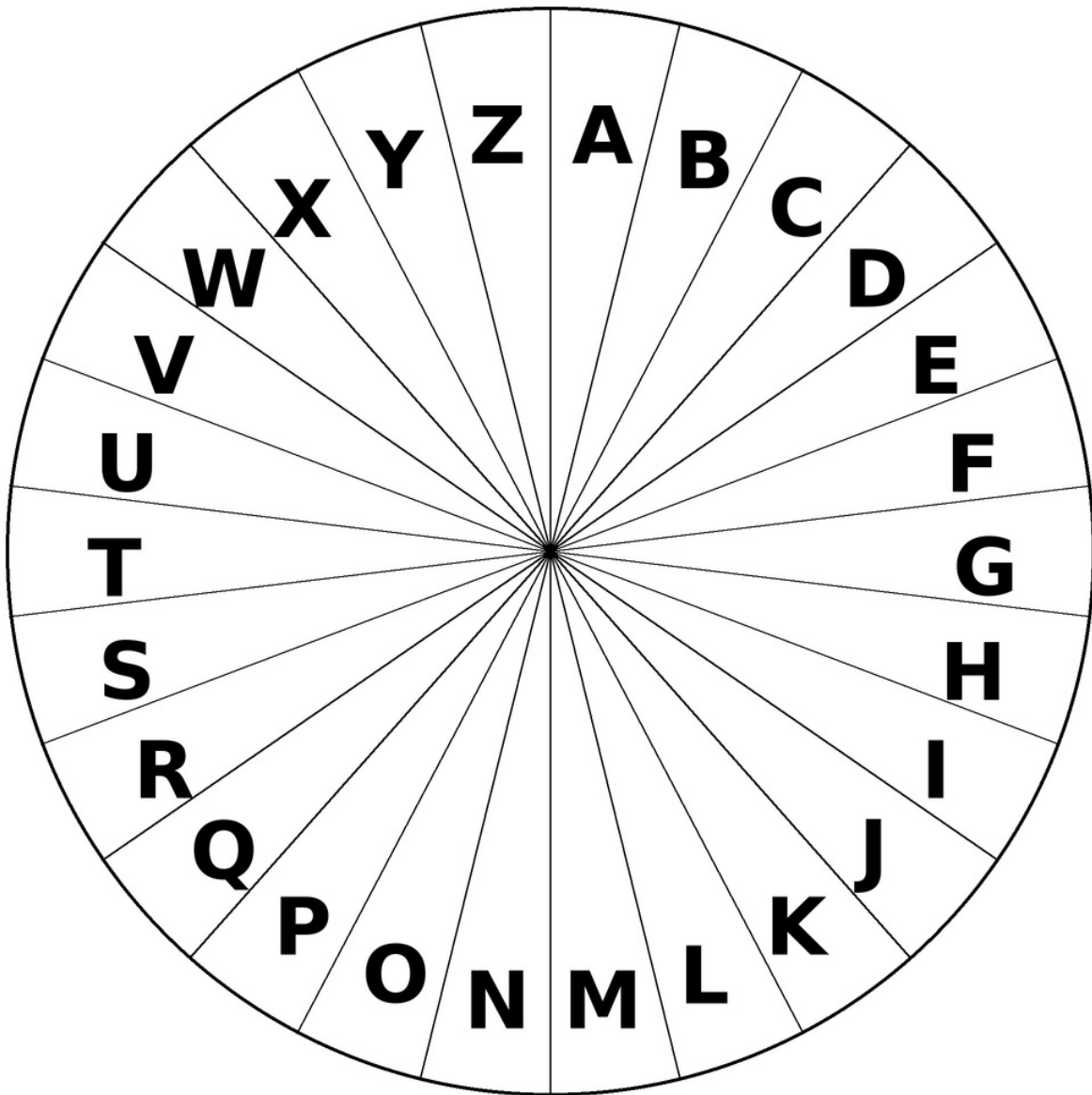
How to Win
