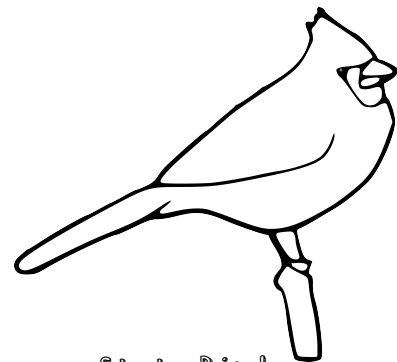

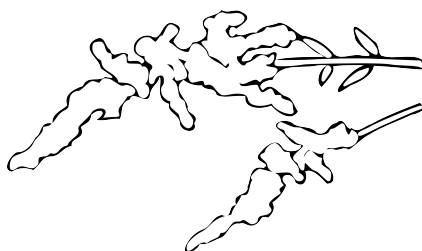
State Tree:
Tulip Poplar



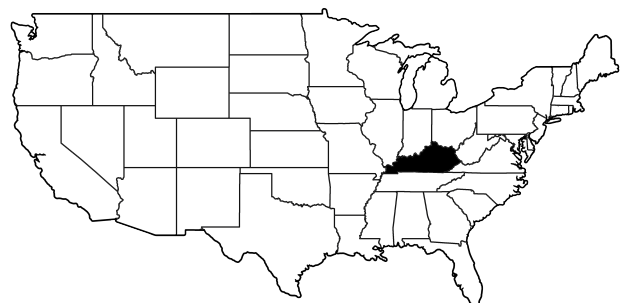

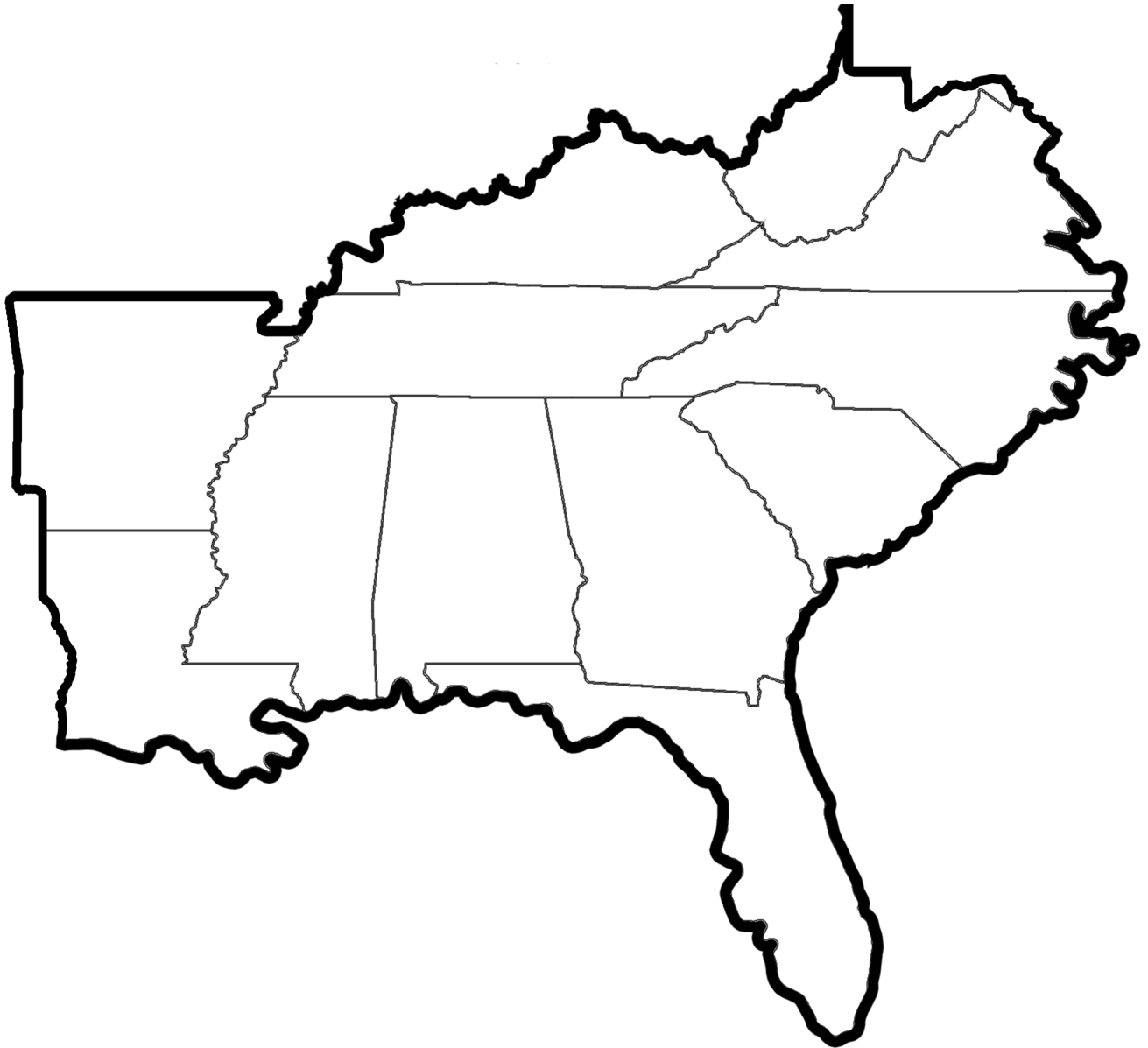

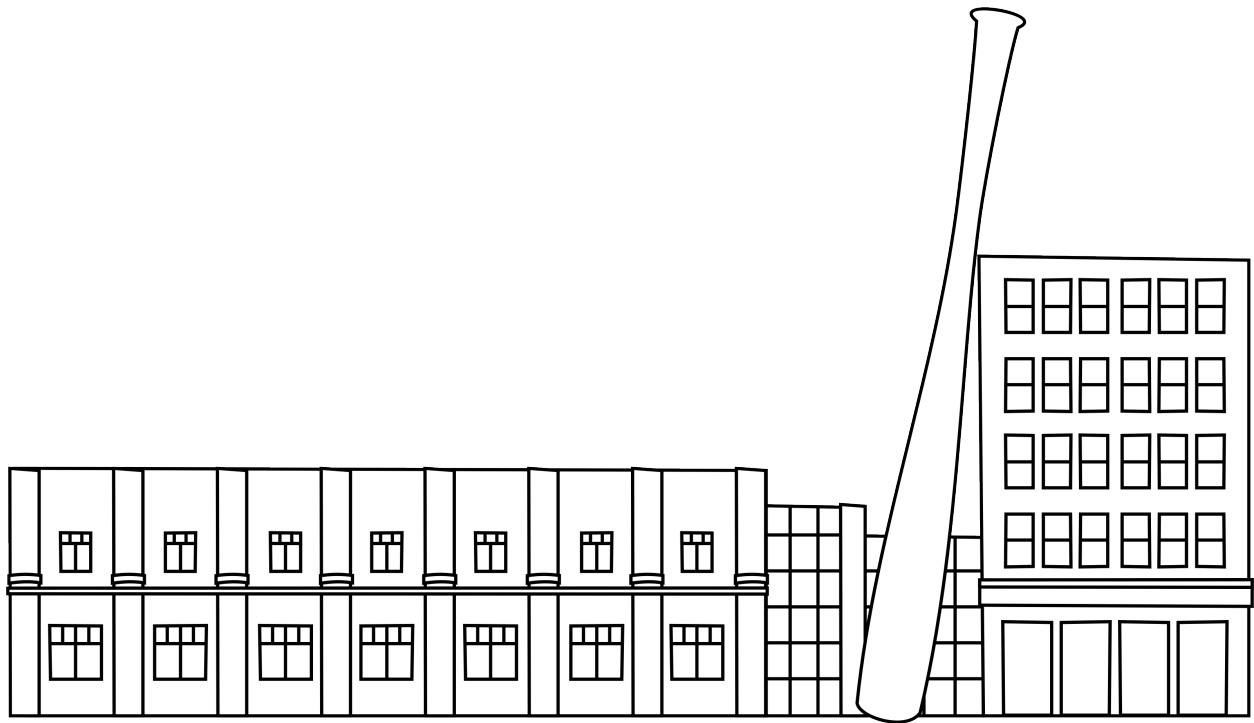
